# Latreille Lake Lodge

Welcome to Latreille Lake Lodge. We are located 65 miles east of Red Lake, Ontario and accessible only by float plane. Our guests have the choice of the American Plan package at the lodge or a trip to one of our two outposts; Margaret Lake Outpost or the Allison Lake Outpost. The waters are teeming with fish, the land is abundant with wildlife and you are just a boat ride away from taking it all in!



### American Plan Lodge



Latreille Lake Lodge is a fly-in American Plan fishing lodge located 65 miles east of Red Lake, Ontario and is a short 30 minute flight by float plane. There is always an owner/operator present to ensure your vacation will be a huge success! We are chosen by experienced professionals because we pay great attention to detail and do whatever it takes to make your trip both enjoyable and relaxing.

### The Lodge

The Lodge is positioned on a beautiful scenic point with ten double occupancy bedrooms and four fully equipped bathrooms. The common area consists of a large dining area, wood burning stove, rocking chairs, game tables, dartboard and TV/DVD player. Outside the common area is a large screened-in porch with a ping pong table for evening tournaments. Off of the screened-in porch is an elevated deck which has a wonderful breeze most of the time and is perfect for observing horseshoe tournaments. It is also a great place for sunbathing, reading a book, taking a nap, watching northern lights or viewing satellites moving across the evening sky.

### Private Cabin

Another choice at the lodge is our private cabin. It is located behind the lodge and is positioned toward the south with a sand beach and spectacular view that stretches the entire length of Latreille Lake. The private cabin will accommodate up to eight people and offers more privacy, yet is close enough to reach all facilities on foot. It is equipped with a wood stove, four double occupancy rooms, one fully equipped bathroom, living room and an elevated wood deck which faces the lake. All meals are served in the lodge and guests are also welcome to use the facilities in the lodge as well.



# About the Lodge

## Excellent Fishing

Latreille Lake, Margaret Lake, Marsh Lake and Allison Lake are located on the Wenasaga River system which is a tremendous natural fishery containing walleye, northern pike and yellow perch. The lakes are constantly being supplied with fish from this river system and the fishing has always been above our customers' expectations. To make it even better, we promote conservation fishing and ask that all large fish be returned to the water immediately after measuring and taking a photo. This helps to eliminate stress on the fish and also helps to sustain the ecosystem and provide future offspring to catch and release.

## Marine Equipment

We use 16 foot Misty River Boats equipped with dependable late model 9.9 horsepower Yamaha motors. Each boat will accommodate two to three people with ease and are very stable and comfortable to fish in, even in inclement weather. They are equipped with swivel seats with backrests, anchor, paddle, landing net, stringers, minnow bucket, seat cushions, life jackets and an emergency kit.



## Fantastic Meals

We spare no expense when it comes to meals! Three delicious meals served every day in the dining area of the lodge. Meals are served "Buffet Style" across the front of the kitchen and there is no reason for anyone to walk away hungry! Our breads, biscuits, cinnamon rolls and pancakes are all made from scratch in our well equipped kitchen. Lunches usually consist of soups and stews for cool days along with sandwiches...and a shore lunch sometime during your stay, weather permitting. Sack lunches are prepared for guests who prefer to stay out all day. Dinners include fresh walleye, prime rib, pork loin, T-bone steaks, lasagna, barbecue chicken complimented with fresh salads and vegetables. And if you have room, we also pile on the desserts including homemade ice cream!

## A Typical Day At The Lodge

Depending on the time of year, the sun comes up about 4:30 am and goes down at 10:30 pm. Coffee is brewing by 6:00 am. For early risers a percolator coffee pot is waiting on the stove. Breakfast is served 7:00 am to 8:00 am. Lunch is served at 1:00 pm or a sack lunch is provided for fishermen who would rather stay out all day. A shore lunch is not out of the question. Dinner is served 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Some people prefer to stay in after dinner while others have the need to go out until dark or fish off of the dock. There have been several trophy fish caught right off our dock! We have a laid back atmosphere and will also arrange our dining schedule to meet the needs of your party.



# Fly-in Outposts

Enjoy the comfort of one of our two remote fly-in outpost camps. Our rates include Round trip float plane transportation from Red Lake, Ontario, fully furnished cabin with refrigerator, stove, range, hot and cold running water, gas grill, propane fish cooker and satellite phone. There is an ample supply of staple foods consisting of canned fruits and vegetables, onions and potatoes, salt and pepper, paper plates and towels, cooking and eating utensils, toilet paper, dish towels and cleaning supplies. Late Model 14 foot Naden boats are equipped with late model 8 horsepower Yamaha motor (with spares), unlimited gasoline, swivel seats with backrest, cushions, life jackets, landing net, anchor, paddle, minnow bucket and stringer. Our outposts are the only ones located on each lake.

One of the comforts of our outposts is knowing that there is help nearby in case you need it. The lodge is 20 minutes away by boat from the Margaret Outpost and 30 minutes away by boat from the Allison Outpost. Most outposts are completely remote with no ability to get help should the need arise. We are there if you need us!

There is an abundance of walleye and northern pike fishing with walleye averaging 1-1/2 to 2-1/2 pounds per catch and northern pike averaging three to six pounds per catch with numerous fish caught above these averages. Conservation fishing licenses are mandatory. This is to ensure the ecosystem of our waters and is also in cooperation with the Ministry of Natural Resources. Our outpost trips are "For Consumption Only" with no take home fish allowed.



## Margaret Lake Outpost

The Margaret Lake Outpost Cabin is located 65 miles east of Red Lake, Ontario (35 minute flight) and will accommodate groups from 4 to 12 guests with trip lengths from four to seven days. Margaret Lake is the largest of all of the connecting lakes with additional fishing action in the Wenasaga River, Latreille Lake and Marsh Lake.

## Allison Lake Outpost

The Allison Lake Outpost is located south of Latreille Lake (35 minute flight) and will accommodate groups from 4 to 10 guests with trip lengths from four to seven days.

The Allison Outpost is the place to go for complete privacy during your stay. You will be in complete solitude if this is your wish or you have the choice to portage into our other three lakes.

# What's Included

## AMERICAN PLAN LODGE

Our American Plan package includes round trip float plane transportation from Red Lake, Ontario. Also included are: lodging, meals, boat, motor, fuel, shore lunches, ice, coolers and maps. Each bedroom is supplied with fresh linens, blankets and pillows. Bathrooms are supplied with towels and washcloths and have hot and cold running water and indoor plumbing. Boats are equipped with a 9.9 horsepower Yamaha motor, full tank of fuel, swivel seats with backrests, anchor, paddle, landing net, stringers, minnow bucket, seat cushions and an emergency kit.

### Communications

There is a satellite telephone available at the lodge for emergency purposes. You will be given the phone number prior to your arrival to leave with family members. The satellite phone is to be used for emergency purposes only. Wireless satellite Internet is available at no charge if you have a notebook computer, i-Pad or i-Phone that you would like to bring along.

### Guides

Guides are available with advance notice but typically not needed during your stay. Some guests request a guide for the first few days to get accustomed to the lakes and then venture out on their own for the rest of the trip.



## OUTPOSTS

Round-trip float plane transportation from Red Lake, Ontario, fully furnished cabin with refrigerator, stove, range, hot and cold running water, gas grill, propane fish cooker and satellite phone. There is an ample supply of staple foods consisting of canned fruits and vegetables, onions and potatoes, salt and pepper, paper plates and towels, toilet paper, dish towels and cleaning supplies. Late Model 14 foot Naden boats are equipped with late model 8 horsepower Yamaha motor (with spares), unlimited gasoline, swivel seats with backrest, cushions, life jackets, landing net, anchor, paddle, minnow bucket and stringer.

# Planning Your Trip

## RESERVATIONS

A deposit of \$300.00 per person is required. Reservations are not confirmed without a deposit. The deposit may be paid by cash, check or credit card. All prices are paid in US Funds. The balance of funds is to be paid by cash or check. There will be a handling fee if a credit card is used for the balance. Reservations should be made as early as possible to ensure your dates and the camp of your choice. All rates are subject to 13% HST tax.

There is no designated day that we require your group to arrive or depart. We accommodate groups according to their schedule as much as possible. The earlier the trip is scheduled, the more likely it is that we can accommodate your arrival and departure plans.

## PASSPORTS AND CROSSING THE BORDER

Passports are now mandatory to re-enter the United States. The law is a requirement of the United States Department of Homeland Security and not the Canadian Government. Up to date information is available at the Homeland Security website at [www.dhs.gov](http://www.dhs.gov). If you do not have a passport, we recommend that you apply immediately because it can

take several weeks to obtain. The passport process can be started at a United States Post Office. If a member of your group has a DUI or felony on their record, or there is a question of legal ability to cross the Canadian border, we recommend you visit the tourism website at [www.canadawelcomesyou.net](http://www.canadawelcomesyou.net) or call us for assistance.

## TRANSPORTATION

### Private Aircraft

There is a 5,000 foot hard surface runway in Red Lake for small aircraft and private jets. We will be happy to discuss the travel options for you and assist with travel arrangements if requested.

### Commercial Flights

Delta Airlines is probably the best air service for flights to International Falls and Winnipeg. Check out their website at [www.delta.com](http://www.delta.com) for flight information or call us for more recommendations.

### Ground Transportation

We will be happy to assist you with ground transportation from any airport. Car rentals are also available at most airports.

# Bear and Moose Hunting



Bear hunting takes place from August 15th every year through mid September. Bear hunters stay at the lodge and all home cooked meals are included. Moose hunting begins in late September and are completed by mid-October. Moose hunts are usually sold out one year in advance so it is important to book early. Latreille Lake Lodge is allocated two bull tags and three cow tags each year. We have an abundance of moose in the area and only five tags in our possession. We would be happy to discuss our hunts in further detail.



## Travel Arrangements

Red Lake, Ontario is located 250 miles from International Falls, Minnesota on Crown Highway 105. Take your shortest route to International Falls & cross the border into Fort Frances, Ontario. From there take Highway 11 East to Highway 502 (about 20 miles). Go North on Highway 502 to Dryden. Go west on Highway 17 to Vermillion Bay. Turn North on Highway 105 to Red Lake. You will be given specific directions on your final confirmation letter.
